Here are examples of English expressions you can use with your child!

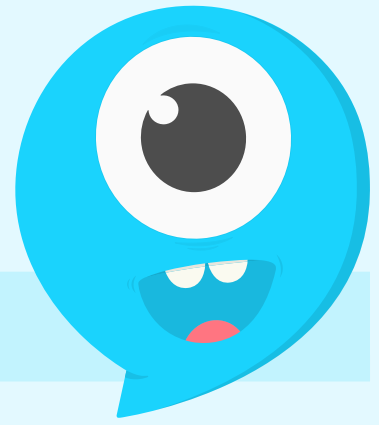
Is your cup of milk empty? Let's fill it up!

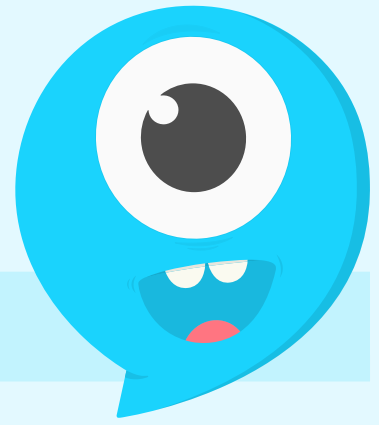
